4. **Row 4:** Dc in next dc, *ch 2, dc in ch-2 space, ch 2, dc in next dc; repeat from * across (6 ch-2 spaces). Ch 1, turn.
5. **Row 5:** Repeat Row 4 seven more times.
6. **Row 13:** Ch 3, dc in next 2 dc, *ch 2, slip stitch in next ch-2 space, ch 2, dc in next 2 dc; repeat from * across (6 ch-2 spaces). Fasten off yarn, leaving a long tail.
7. **Fold and Sew:** Fold the bonnet in half, matching the side edges. Using the yarn tail, sew the side edges together from the brim to the top of the crown.
8. **Create the Booties:** Ch 15, dc in 10th ch from hook, dc in each ch across (5 dc). Ch 1, turn.

9. **Row 2:** Dc in each dc across (5 dc). Ch 1, turn.
10. **Row 3:** Ch 3, dc in next 3 dc, *ch 2, skip 1 dc, dc in next dc; repeat from * across (4 ch-2 spaces). Ch 1, turn.
11. **Row 4:** Repeat Row 3 four more times.
12. **Fold and Sew:** Fold the bootie in half, matching the side edges. Sew the side edges together from the heel to the toe.
13. **Attach Booties to Bonnet:** Thread the yarn needle and sew the booties securely to the front of the bonnet.

- Use a stitch marker to mark the beginning of each round.
- Count your stitches regularly to ensure accuracy.
